Day 1 Highlights (6th November 2025)

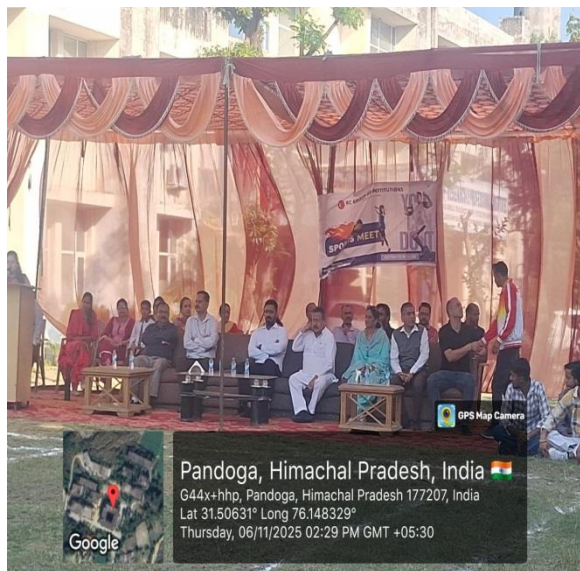
