

2. Objectives

- To offer free medical check-ups and specialized consultations to students.
- To raise awareness about hygiene, nutrition, and lifestyle-related diseases.
- To distribute free medicines to those in need.
- To provide hands-on experience for pharmacy/medical students in patient counselling.

3. Activities and Services

- **General Health Check-up:** Doctors performed check-ups and provided consultations for common ailments.
- **Vitals Tracking:** Dedicated counters for blood pressure, blood sugar (glucometer), and body mass index (BMI) monitoring.
- **Specialized Screening:** Services included dentistry (oral care), ophthalmology (eye check-up), and dermatology.
- **Pharmacy:** Free essential drugs were dispensed based on prescriptions.
- **Awareness Sessions:** Volunteers conducted health talks and demonstrated hygiene techniques.
